







Made in Alaska



When purchasing products in Alaska, look for the mother bear and her cub logo signifying the product was manufactured in Alaska. The Made in Alaska program mission is to promote products made, manufactured, or handcrafted in the state. Products which are 51% or more produced in Alaska are eligible to use the Made in Alaska logo and certify the product's authenticity.

Alaska Grown



The Alaska Grown logo identifies those agricultural products that are grown in Alaska and serves as a country of origin label for the USDA. The logo is supported by the Alaska Division of Agriculture.

Alaska Silver Hand



The Silver Hand logo indicates that the artwork on which it appears is created by hand in Alaska by an individual Alaska Native artist. The Silver Hand program helps Alaska Native artists promote their work in the marketplace and enables consumers to identify and purchase authentic Alaska Native Art. The Silver Hand program was created by the Alaska State Council on the Arts in the 1980's.



SOUTHEAST ALASKA LOCAL BUSINESS MAP




